INVITATION TO APPLY FOR ELIGIBILITY AND TO RE-BID
Re-Bidding for the Purchase of :

PCSO ITNI Module 3 Lot 1 : Expansion of Data and Voice Network

The Philippine Charity Sweepstakes Office (PCSO) through the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) intends to apply the sum of **Forty Six Million Nine Hundred Sixty Six Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (P46,966,500.00)** being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) of the Project. Bids received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at Bid Opening.


The PCSO now invites Bids from eligible Bidders with multi disciplinary expertise and/or experience in the fields of Information and Communications Technology (ICT), Electrical Engineering, Civil Engineering, Interior Architecture, with valid PCAB License, an experience working in a classified heritage building, for the Expansion of Data, Voice, Video Network at PCSO Main Office. Work shall include Network Design, Supply, Delivery, Installation, Configuration and Training for the following:

1. Structured Cabling System For Data and Voice Connectivity
2. Connectivity Management System Software and related Security System Software
3. Network Access Switches
4. Internet Protocol Private Branch Exchange (IPPBX) Systems
5. IP Camera and Wireless Access Point (WAP)

Delivery of the GOODS shall be for a period of **180 calendar days** from the date of receipt by the winning bidder of the Notice to Proceed (NTP). The description of an eligible Bidder is contained in Section II of the Re-Bidding Documents, Instructions to Bidders, ITB.

Re-Bidding will be conducted through open competitive bidding procedures using non-discretionary pass/fail as specified in the Implementing Rules and Regulations Part A (IRR-A) of Republic Act No. 9184 (R.A. 9184), otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act," and is restricted to Filipino citizens/sole proprietorships, organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights or privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to Republic Act 5183 (R.A. 5183) and subject to Commonwealth Act 138 (C.A. 138). Only Bids from Bidders who pass the eligibility check will be opened. The process for the eligibility check is described in Section II of the Bidding Documents, ITB. The bidder with the Lowest Calculated Bid (LCB) shall advance to the post-qualification stage in order to finally determine responsiveness of the bid to technical and financial requirements of the project. The contract shall then be awarded to the Lowest Calculated and Responsive Bid (LCRB) who was determined as such during the post-qualification procedure.

Interested Bidders may obtain further information from the PCSO and inspect the Re-Bidding Documents at the address given below from 8:00am to 5:00pm.

A complete set of Re-Bidding Documents may be purchased by interested Bidders from the address below and upon payment of a nonrefundable fee in the amount of **P 10,000.00**. The method of payment will be in **cash**. The date of issuance of Bid Documents will be from **September 2 to 8, 2008**. The Re-Bidding Documents shall be received personally by the prospective Bidder or his authorized representative. 

The PCSO-BAC will hold a Pre-Bidding Conference open to all interested parties on **September 15, 2008, 10:00am**, at the PCSO Executive Lounge, 4th floor, Main Building, E. Rodriguez Sr. Avenue, Quezon City.

Bids and eligibility requirements must be delivered to the Office of the General Manager located at the 3rd floor of the Main Building **on or before 10:00am of September 30, 2008**. All Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security in the following form and amount. Late Bids shall not be accepted.

Bid opening shall be on **September 30, 2008, 10:30am** at the PCSO Executive Lounge, 4/F, Main Building. Bids will be opened in the presence of the Bidders' representatives who choose to attend the said activity.

The PCSO reserves the right to accept or reject any Bid, to annul the bidding process, and to reject all Bids at any time prior to contract award, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected Bidder or Bidders.
