INVITATION FOR COMPETITIVE CHALLENGE
OF UNSOLICITED PROPOSAL

Establishment and Operation of the First Thermal Coating Plant in the Philippines and Manufacture and Marketing of Paper Products Through a Joint Venture with the Philippine Charity Sweepstakes Office

The Philippine Charity Sweepstakes Office (PCSO) received an unsolicited proposal for a joint venture with the PCSO to Establish and Operate the First Thermal Coating Plant in the Philippines under the framework of the "Guidelines and Procedures for Entering into Joint Venture (JV) Agreements between Government and Private Entities" (JV Guidelines) issued by the National Economic Development Authority (NEDA) pursuant to Executive Order No. 423, which took effect on May 2, 2008.

The PCSO invites interested Private Sector Participants (PSPs) to submit competitive proposals with a Minimum Investment Commitment of Four Billion Four Hundred Million Peso (Php 4,400,000,000.00).

For this purpose, the following schedule shall be strictly observed:

PSPs must possess a track record, experience and expertise in the manufacture and application of thermal coatings to paper and synthetic substrates ranging from 50 gsm to 300 gsm and 50 microns to 300 microns with an existing international customer base. Further, prospective PSPs should have the capability to finance the operation of the entire project.
