Introduction

Pursuant to Section 6, Republic Act No. 1169, as amended (PCSO Charter), the net receipts of the Agency shall be divided into the following funds:

55% <u>PRIZE FUND</u>	30% <u>CHARITY FUND</u>	15% <u>OPERATING FUND</u>

The **Prize Fund**, which is 55% of the net receipts, is used for the payment of prizes, including those for owners and jockeys of running horses and sellers of winning tickets. This is a trust liability account. Unclaimed prizes or balances in Prize Fund reverts and forms part of the Charity Fund after one (1) year.

The **Operating Fund** forms 15% of the revenue allocation, which is used to support the day-to-day operating/maintenance and capital expenditures of the PCSO. If there is a balance on the Operating Fund at the end of the fiscal year, it reverts and forms part of the Charity Fund.

The **Charity Fund**, 30% of the PCSO net receipts, is a trust liability account used exclusively to finance and support health programs, medical assistance and services and/or charities of national character.

OPERATIONAL ACCOMPLISHMENTS

FUND PROVISION (Corporate Social Responsibility)

Individual Medical Assistance Program

The Individual Medical Assistance Program (IMAP) is PCSO's flagship medical assistance program which extends financial assistance for medical and hospitalization expenses of in need and sick Filipinos, regardless of class or status, through the issuance of guarantee letters (GLs) to partner public and private hospitals.

From April 1 to June 30, 2019, a total of **121,619 patients** were served all over the country, which is 4.63% higher than the number of patients assisted during the same period in 2018. Furthermore, the amount of allocated IMAP assistance amounted to **P1,304,636,517.61**. The table below shows the monthly distribution of IMAP assistance:

Further, in terms of the nature of requests, confinement was the top requested assistance with 48,734 patients served from April 1 to June 30, 2019, followed by the request for chemotherapeutics and other specialized medicines with 44,010 beneficiaries. Meanwhile, 12,548 patients requested for laboratory and diagnostic procedures, while 8,988 patients asked for dialysis (hemodialysis and peritoneal). Further, implant/prosthesis/medical devices were granted to 2,962 beneficiaries. Lastly, 4,377 beneficiaries asked for other requests such as radiation treatment, surgery, laser treatment, medical appliances, and therapy.

Medical and Dental Mission

From April 1 to June 30, 2019, a total of **3,167** patients benefitted from the Medical and Dental Mission in various parts of the country, which is 105% or 1,622 patients higher than 2nd quarter of 2018. PCSO provided **P195,507.79** worth of medical and dental assistance for the 2nd quarter of 2019, compared to only P128,616.45 during the same period of 2018.

Out-patient Consultation Program

During the 2nd quarter of 2019, PCSO served **4,059** patients for their medical and health services worth **P724,803.74** at the PCSO Extension Office at the Lung Center of the Philippines. The number of beneficiaries and amount of assistance granted are 26% and 108% higher than the figures during the same period of 2018 respectively.

Medicine Donation Program

PCSO also augments medicines in kind to Government and Non-Government agencies to help them in the delivery of health care services within their areas of concerns. Within the 2nd quarter of 2019, PCSO granted medicines worth **P914,782.20** to **36** organizations throughout the country. The amount is 214% higher than 2nd quarter of 2018, while the number of beneficiaries is 260% higher compared to the same period of 2018.

Employees, Dependents, and Retirees Consultation and Management Services

During the second quarter of 2019, PCSO provided a total of **P157,051.31** for the medical and dental services of **7,764** employees, their dependents, and retirees at the PCSO Extension Office at the Lung Center of the Philippines. This is 20% and 114% higher than the number of patients and amount of assistance given to them during the same period of 2018 respectively. 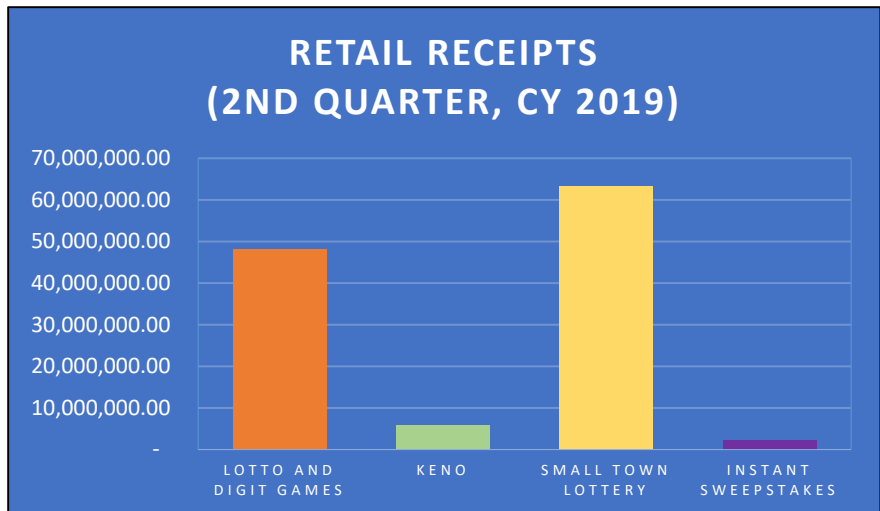

Retail Receipts

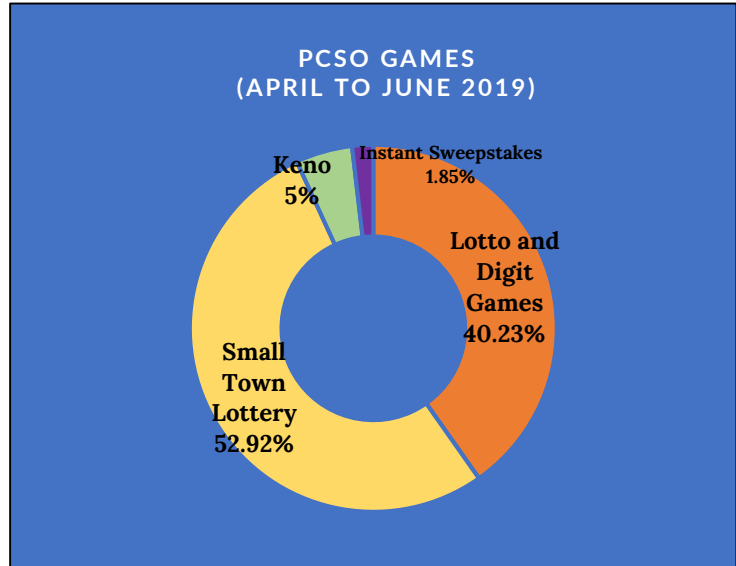
For the 2nd quarter of 2019, PCSO generated a total of **P11,968,898,585.39** from its Lotto, Keno, Digit Games, Small Town Lottery, and Instant Sweepstakes.

The Small Town Lottery gained the highest retail receipts amounting to

P6,333,367,105.39, followed by the Lotto and Digit Games which yielded a total of **P4,815,639,680.00**. Meanwhile, Keno amounted to **P598,091,800.00** and Instant Sweepstakes with **P221,800,000.00**.



Based on the pie chart (right), the Small Town Lottery is the biggest earner, contributing 52.92% of the total sales from April 1 to June 30, 2019, followed by Lotto and Digit Games with 40.23%, Keno with 5%, and Instant Sweepstakes with 1.85%.

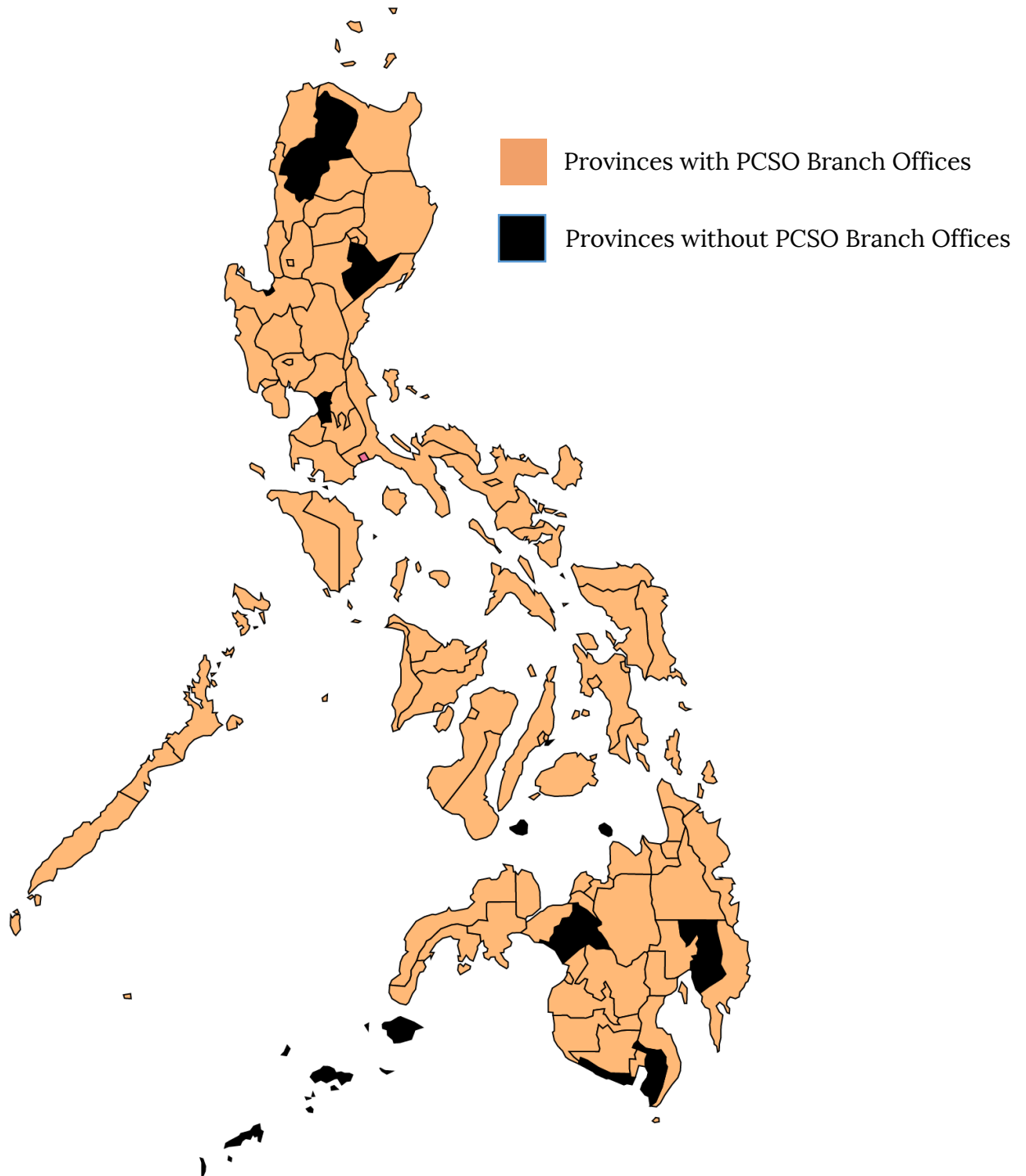
